

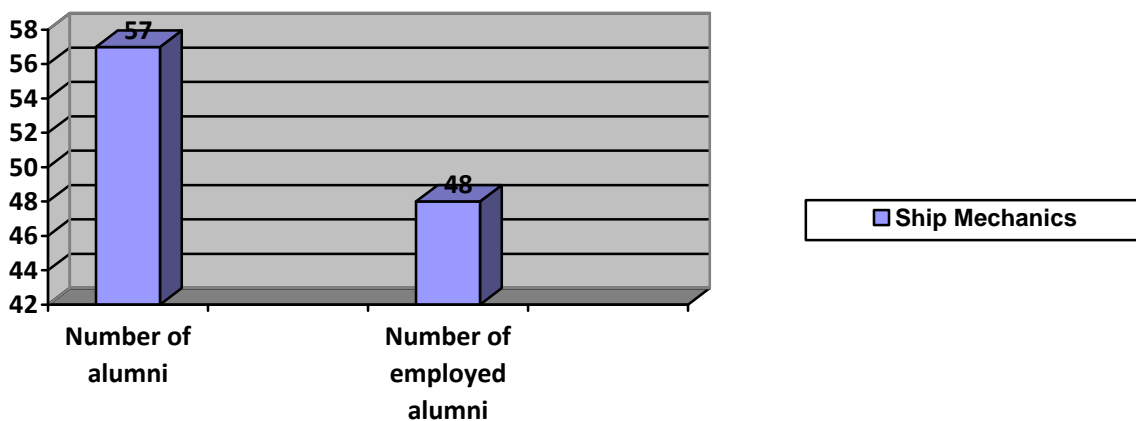
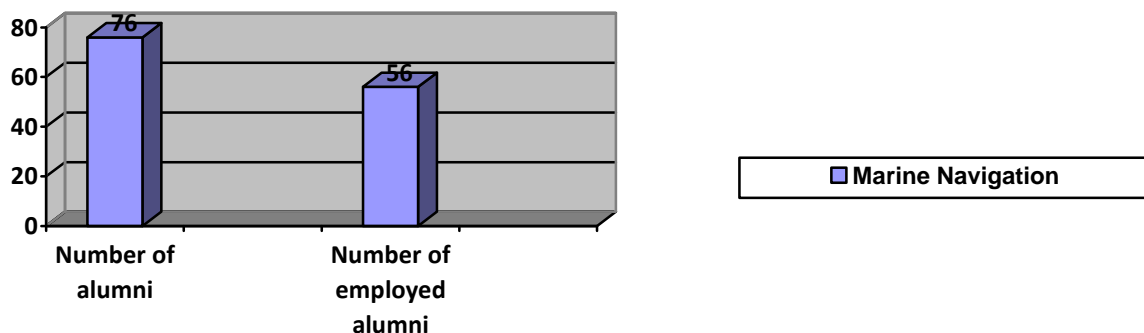


**Employment Figures
Higher Educational Programmes**

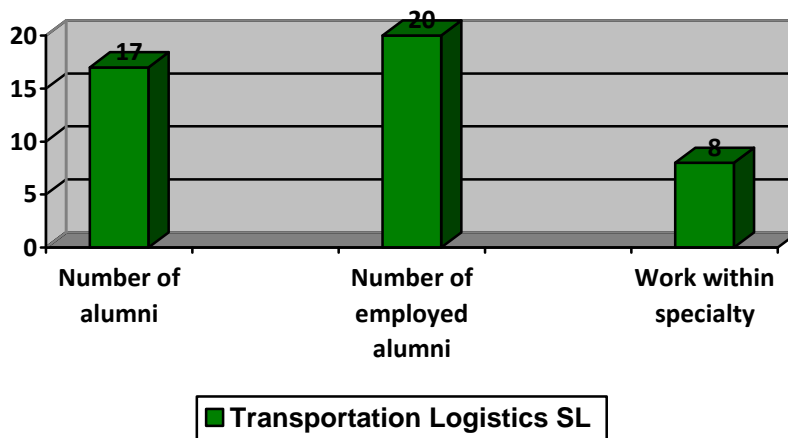
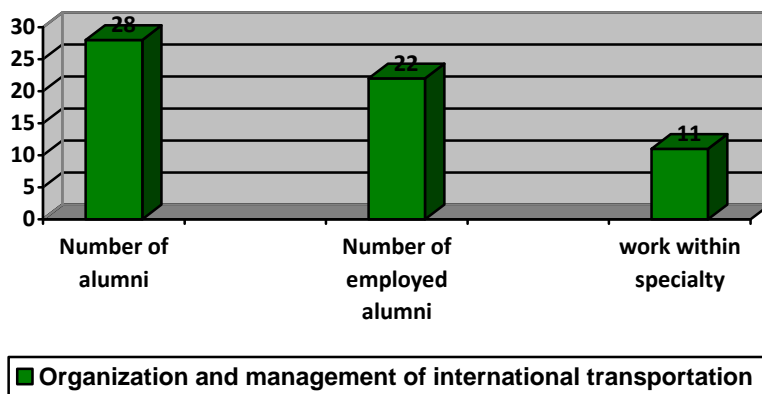
(2013-2018)

On April 16-19, 2018 Quality Assurance Service of Batumi Navigation Teaching University conducted one-time survey of potential employers of Marine-Engineering and Logistics Faculties (questionnaires are attached to the document), by means of which number of BNTU alumni employed in 2013-2018 period by crewing and logistics companies having contractual relationships with BNTU was determined.

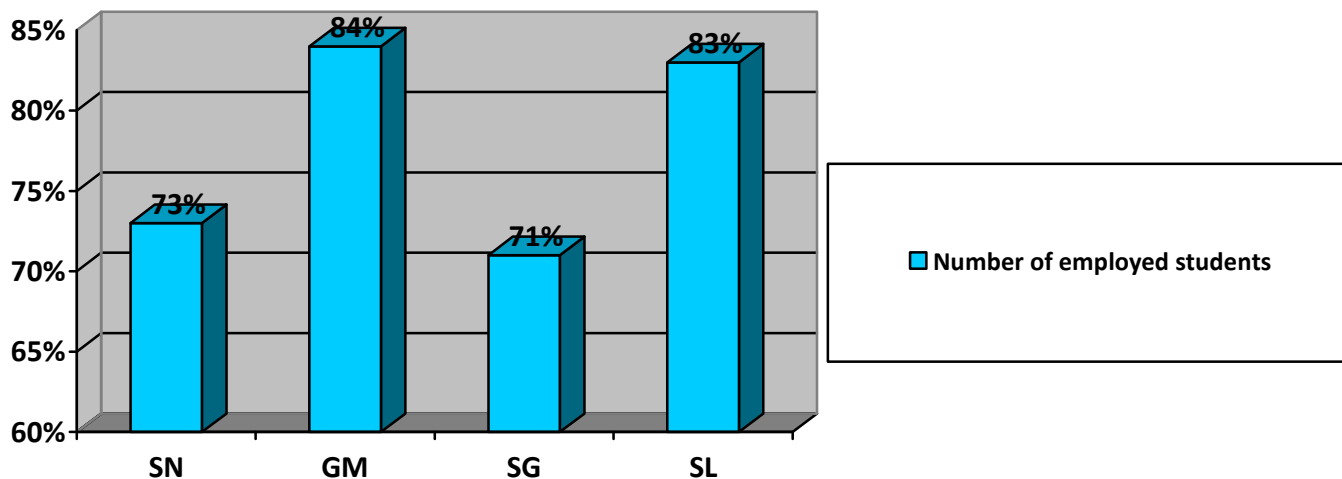
On the basis of survey it was determined that during reporting period 9 crewing companies have employed totally 104 alumni of Bachelor’s educational programmes of Marine-Engineering Faculty, including 56 alumni of Bachelor’s educational programme “Marine Navigation” out of 76 (73%), 48 alumni of Bachelor’s educational programme “Ship Mechanics” out of 57 (84%). All of the alumni work within their specialty.



Moreover, BNTU Quality Assurance Service conducted phone survey of alumni of the Faculty of Logistics, on the basis of which it was determined that 22 alumni of Bachelor’s educational programme “Organization and management of international transportation” out of 28 (79%) are employed, among them 11 (50%) work within their specialty; today, 14 alumni of Master’s educational programme “Transportation Logistics” out of 17 are employed (83%), including 8 (57%) persons working within their specialty.



Hence, withing the period of 2013-18, figures, indicating employment of BNTU alumni are as follows:



Conclusion:

Results of represented analysis shall be taken into consideration in future activity of BNTU and during determination of vacancies for students by faculties.



BNTU Internship and employment service must enhance its activity towards provision of student internship and professional orientation-related issues.

During business meetings with potential employers the problem of employment in logistic field was highlighted – at present stage of formation and development of logistic field in Georgia, logistic potential of the country is poorly utilized. So, along with development of logistic processes in the country, demand on high-qualified experts of this field will be increased.
