- File type - Microsoft Word, sheet size – A4; margins: top, bottom, left and right – 2 cm.; font size - Times New Roman – 14; line spacing – 1,5; Text alignment – Breadthwise.
- Volume of the conference abstract from 3 to 4 pages (inclusive).
- List of references (with no repetition) is formed at the end of the conference abstract and it is titled as "References". In the text of the paper, footnotes are in square brackets with the source and page number, for example: [5, p. 16].
